RESIDENCY PROGRAMME IN DIRECTING

Eligibility

- Singaporean
- Previous directing experience preferably in professional setting. Experience in other production areas is an advantage
- Serious intention to pursue professional career in directing
- Fulltime availability for duration of residency period

Programme description

Singapore Repertory Theatre's Residency Programme offers the opportunity to be actively involved in the day-to-day workings of one of the leading theatre companies in Asia. Residents receive immersive hands-on training in their chosen specialities by working closely alongside local and international colleagues on a wide range of projects.

The Directing Resident will be assigned to several shows during the residency period and will assist the directors of each show. The nature of the assistantship will vary with each show and may include rehearsing understudies, running warm ups, preparing promotional appearances, general show maintenance, etc.

The Resident will also assist SRT's Deputy Artistic Director with programming research, casting and other aspects of producing SRT's season.

Programme duration

The Resident will be expected to make a full-time commitment for 24 months. A monthly stipend will be provided to assist the Resident with living expenses for the duration of this training programme.

Application procedure

Please submit the following materials

1. Current CV
2. A 600-800 word statement addressing the following questions:
 - What motivates your interest in directing?
 - How have you developed this interest so far and what has been your biggest achievement as a director?
 - What would a successful directing career look like for you?
 - Why is the Residency the right step for you at this time?
 - What knowledge or skills are you looking to develop during the Residency?
 - What aspects of SRT's work most interests you?
 - How will SRT and the local theatre industry benefit from your contribution?
3. A 400-500 word description of your dream project
 - What show would you do and what would the experience be like?
 - Why is this project important?
 - How would you go about making it happen?
 - How can the Residency Programme help you realise this project?
