
Singapore Repertory Theatre has a vacancy for a full-time **Technical Supervisor (Venue)**.

The Technical Supervisor is responsible for all technical personnel, equipment and processes necessary to ensure the smooth functioning of the KC Arts Centre – Home of Singapore Repertory Theatre. This role reports to SRT's Venue Manager and Deputy Artistic Director and supervises a 3-4 person technical team at the KC Arts Centre. The right candidate for this position will enjoy working with a wide variety of local and international theatre artists in an exciting, fast-paced environment.

Duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Overseeing acquisitions, deployment and maintenance of SRT's technical equipment;
- Overseeing maintenance of venue facilities at the KC Arts Centre;
- Growing and managing SRT's network of theatre technicians and equipment/service providers;
- Rostering and managing performance of SRT's full-time and casual technicians;
- Supervising technical work for all productions at the KC Arts Centre, which may include serving as show crew as needed;
- Ensuring all technical work at the KC Arts Centre complies with relevant health and safety guidelines;
- Providing technical assistance and support for other events such as SRT's annual Theatre Ball; and
- Providing general support to SRT's Venue Manager in carrying out her responsibilities.

This job will require work beyond regular office hours, including weekends and public holidays.

Requirements

At least 5 years of prior experience with technical processes for mid to large scale professional theatre productions is strongly recommended.

Applicant's previous work experience must demonstrate ability to carry out the following:

- recommend, source and deploy a wide variety of equipment for all technical theatre areas, including but not limited to set, costumes, props, lighting, sound and multimedia;
- analyze technical specifications and CAD drawings for potential build, installation or maintenance problems;
- identify, troubleshoot and successfully resolve problems in all technical theatre areas;
- lead small to mid-size teams and ensure satisfactory performance standards and outcomes;
- maintain up-to-date in-house technical specifications and equipment inventories;
- independently create and execute maintenance plans for venue facilities;
- ensure compliance with all necessary licenses, permits, insurance and other regulatory requirements;
- effectively manage information flow with multiple departments;
- speak and write at a good standard of English. Proficiency with other local languages is a plus;
- proficiently use a wide range of digital tools, especially Microsoft Office and CAD applications.
