The theatre has 2 entrances.



This is the Merbau Road entrance.

This is the Robertson Walk entrance.



This is the Foyer.



It can get very busy and crowded an hour before the performance starts.

If you need to pick up your tickets, you can do this from the Box Office located in the Foyer.



Our helpful SRT Front of House Staff will be more than happy to help you in any way.

This is what your ticket for the performance will look like.



Stalls are located on the first floor.  
The Circle is located on the second floor.

The alphabet represents the row

The number represents your seat.

In the Foyer, there is a bar where you can buy drinks and snacks.



This area may get crowded and noisy at times.

The toilets are located on the first floor.



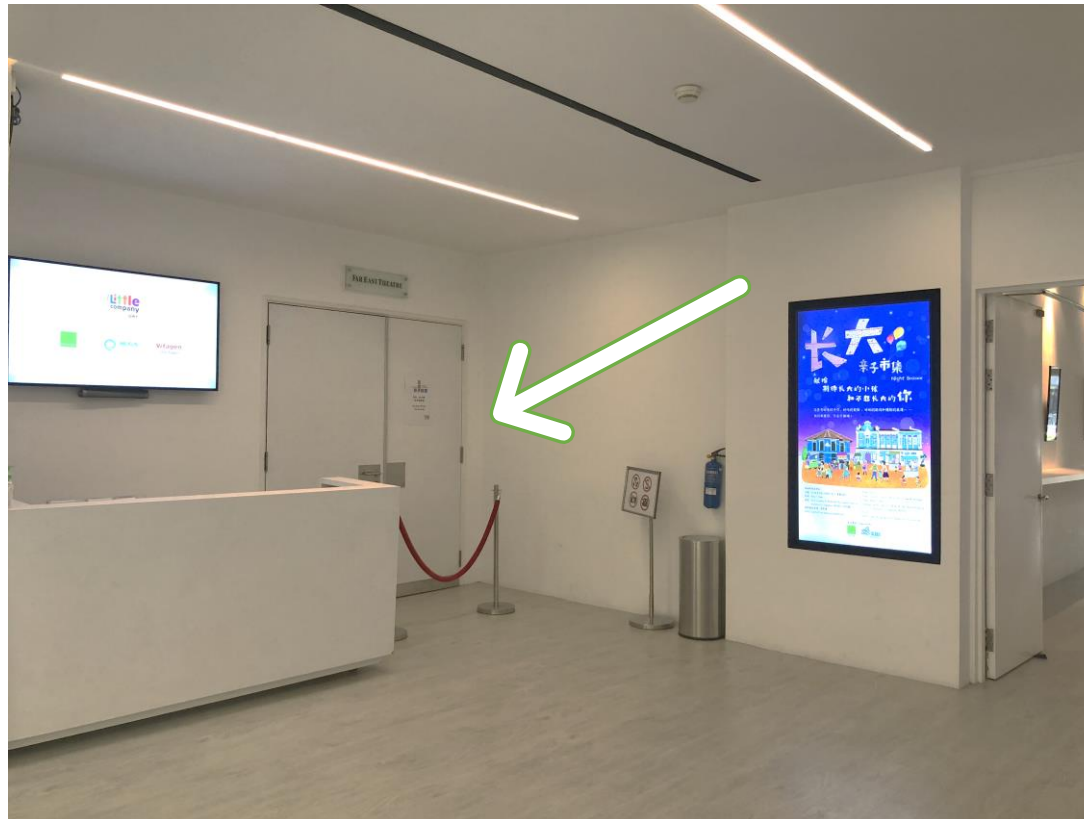


The toilets are located to the right side of the bar.



## Ground Floor – The Foyer

This is where the Box Office, Toilets, Bar and the entrance to the stalls can be found.  
'Stalls' is the name of the seated area on the first floor.



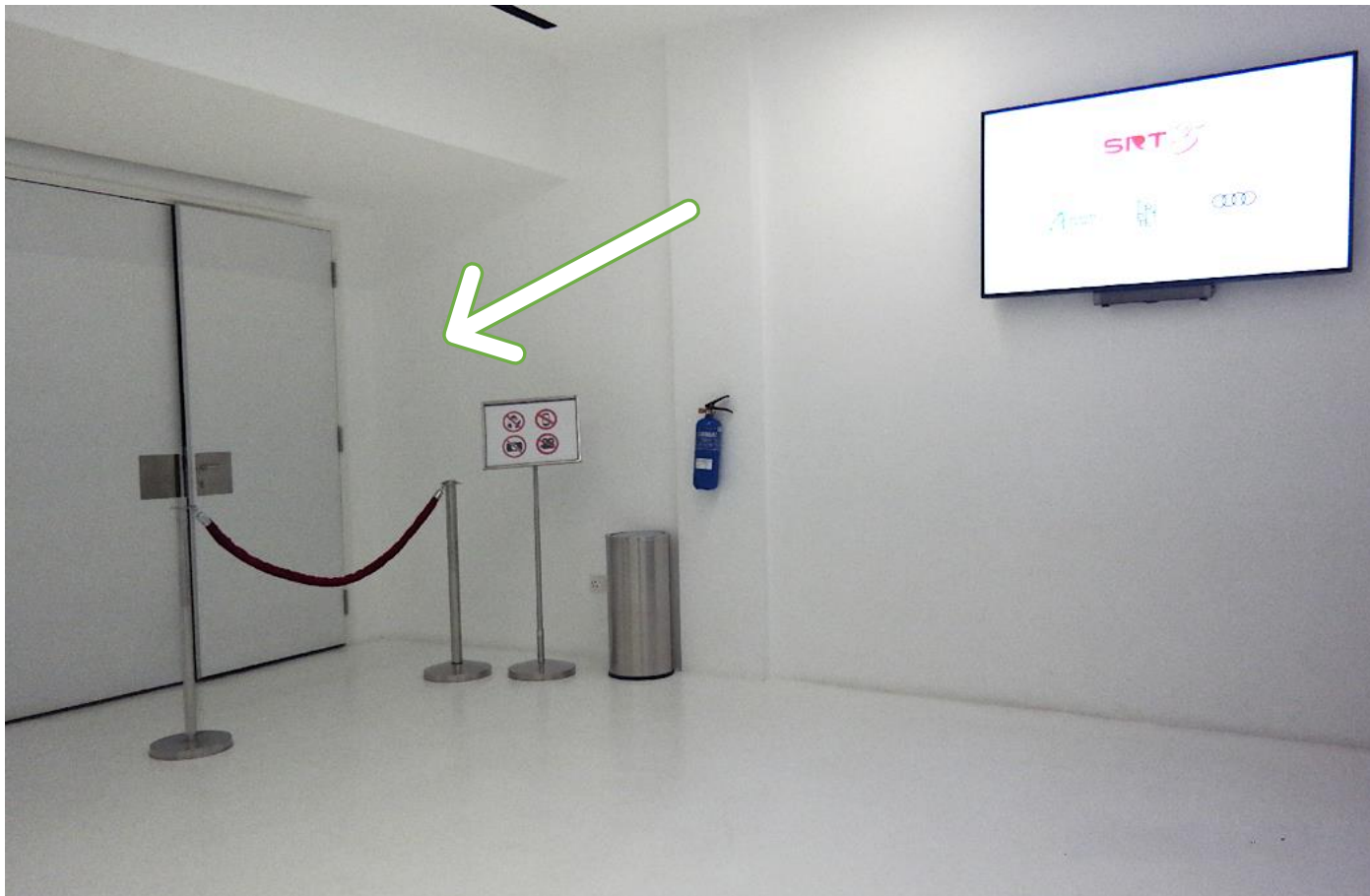
This door will bring you to the stalls seating.

## Second Floor – The Circle



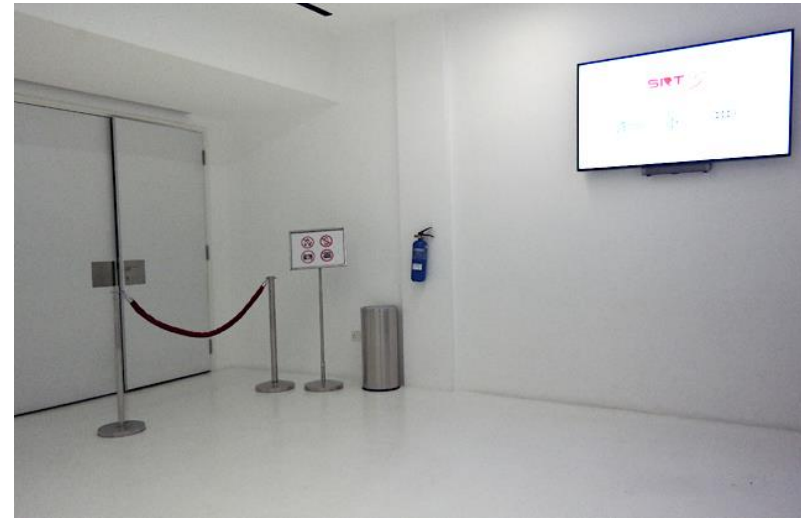
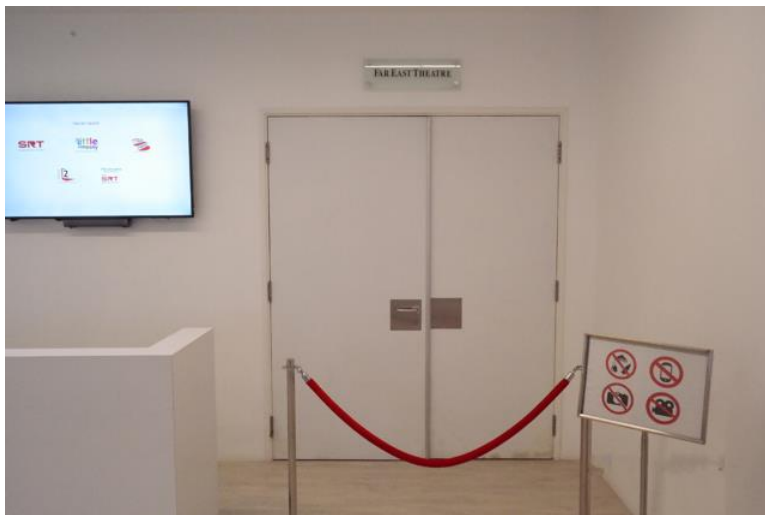
These stairs will take you to the second-floor foyer.

This door will bring you into the Circle level of the auditorium.



Once the actors are ready, the doors will be opened.

A Front of House Staff wearing a black SRT t-shirt will be there to check your ticket.



Once you are in your seat, please silence your mobile devices.

They are not to be used during the performance and you cannot take any pictures.

This is what the Auditorium looks like from the Ground floor.



10 minutes before the performance starts, you will hear a bell.  
This means you can go to your seats.

This will happen again 5 minutes before the performance begins and a final time 2 minutes before the performance begins.

When the performance begins, the lights will go down and the room will get darker.

If you would like to take a break from the performance, you can sit outside the auditorium and watch the performance on our TV screens.

Some of our performances will have a break halfway, which is called **The Interval**.

**It usually lasts for 15 minutes but do listen out for an announcement should there be a longer interval.**

When the interval is almost over, a bell will ring which means that it is now time to go back to your seat.



When the performance ends, the audience will clap their hands, some may even stand and cheer.

The lights will come back on and you can leave through the doors.

A lot of people will use the main exit which will be busy and often crowded and noisy.

Please feel free to stay in your seat until the crowd has dispersed.
